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Lesson plans are the foundations for learning. Teachers use them as outlines for daily activities and principals review them to ensure classrooms are following curriculum standards. However, for most non-formal educators, lesson plans can be difficult to write and challenging to connect with Iowa Core (Iowa's set standards for educational development). With that in mind, Silos & Smokestacks National Heritage Area (SSNHA) has invited Courtney Clausen from the University of Northern Iowa to discuss the Iowa Core, lesson plan development and key instructional strategies.

Throughout the day participants will take a detailed look at the Iowa Core, focusing specifically on how to correlate current site programs to history, language arts and science. After learning more about Iowa Core Standards, participants will develop lesson plans that link to core standards and offer

There will also be time for workshop attendees to explore Heartland Acres Agribition Center, a SSNHA Partner Site, which teaches visitors the importance of agriculture and the overall impact it has on EVERYONE... even YOU!
