Twitter isn't right for everything. Different platforms have different strengths.






Early Planning and Goals

Trending: Start sharing early

The more stakeholders you can involve early on, the better.

- Received mini-grant to support project
- Brought scholars together with the public

Tweets


- First-person accounts

Tweets

- Tweet early and often!
- Spread the word about #QR1863 with a party
- Work with local internet provider to ensure reliable wireless network
- Final meeting/dress rehearsal

Tweets

- 1.3 million accounts reached
- 5 million impressions
- 7,800 tweets
- 1,824 accounts used #QR1863
- Trending worldwide throughout August 21

Trending: Measure success

Find a way to track Twitter involvement. The results will impress boards and bosses.



The Response

Tweets

- National and local media coverage
- Won over skeptics
- People were late to appointments and did little work
- No 'hijacking' took place

Tweets

- Spawned similar projects
- Developing searchable database of tweets with educational programming
- Replay automatically and add additional historic voices

Trending: Think long-term

We didn't plan for a future for this project...the public asked for it.





What did we learn?

Tweets

- Collaboration helps project grow
- Give volunteers freedom to work within a system
- Call attention to your good work!
- Like other public programming, plan for the worst and enjoy success
- You can do this alone, but working with the community creates a bigger impact and is more rewarding
