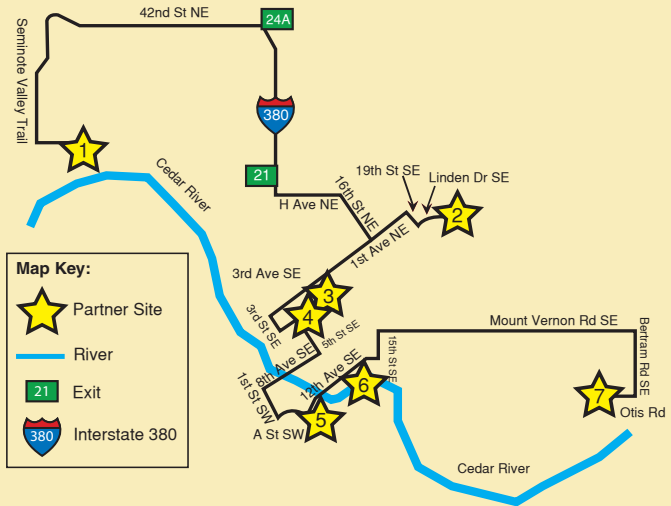

1. Usher's Ferry Historic Village

Admission: \$2 adults, \$1 children 3-14, 2 years & under free

Iowa's only National Trust Historic Site, Brucemore is a 26-acre park-like estate in the heart of Cedar Rapids. The estate continues to be a hub for cultural, philanthropic and educational activities.

4. Cedar Rapids Museum of Art

Admission: \$5 adults, \$4 college students & seniors (65+), children 18 years and under free

Come see the largest collection of works by regionalist artist Grant Wood and visit his studio. There are also 2000 years of art from Roman busts to Marvin Cone.

5. National Czech & Slovak Museum & Library

Admission: \$10 adults, \$9 seniors, \$5 active military & students 14+, \$3 youth 6-13 years, free for children under 5 & members

Located in historic Czech Village, the museum features a new permanent exhibition that includes the history of Czech settlement in America.
