

1. Fontana Interpretive Center (319)-636-2617 Hours: Mon-Tues 8–12, Wed-Fri 8–4:30, Sat-Sun. 1–5 Admission: Free

Explore the nature center learning the links between our environment and agriculture. Meander through the live animal display observing some of Iowa's wildlife. Stroll along the shores of Mink Creek or fish off a jetty.

2. Wapsipinicon Mill Museum (319)-334-4616

Hours: Mid May–Mid Sept, Tues–Sun 12–4 or by appt **Admission:** Free self-guided tours, donations welcome. Group/bus tours \$3/person, Call for reservations.

3. Heartland Acres Agribition Center (319)-332-0123

Hours: April–Oct, Mon–Sat 10–3 Admission: \$10 adults (\$2 discount for groups of 10 or more), \$4 children age 5-17, children 4 yrs & under free, \$3 school tours.
